

General Announcements:



Attendance Record

All students are to clock-in when they arrive at school and clock-out when they leave, using their new Identification Cards. This new process will enhance the safety of our students as this will help us in case of emergencies such as fire or earthquake. Because of this requirement, all students must be dropped off and picked up through the main office. The students are to wait in the lobby until they are released to go home. Students should not cut across the parking lot from the covered area when they see their family car. As a reminder, the attendance record will be a part of the students' eligibility for honors and 'STARS' awards.



Flu Season: Fall flu season is starting soon. The disease is spread from person to person through coughing and sneezing, or contact with an infected person or contaminated object. You can lower your risk of being infected by

- Washing your hands often with soap and water
- Disinfecting dirty surfaces and soiled items
- Avoiding close contact or sharing eating utensils or cups with infected people

We have asked our cleaning staff to thoroughly clean and disinfect surface areas and common contact items as doorknobs, handrails, and floors especially in kindergarten and lower elementary grades classrooms. However, it is also important to remind each student about the value of good healthy hygiene, a good diet, drink plenty of water, and get an adequate amount of sleep each night. If your child shows any symptoms of a cold or flu, it is better for them to stay home rather than continuing to spread the disease or having the symptoms get worse.



- Snacks. We require that the snacks students bring to school to be healthy. Recently some of the snacks are processed cookies (sweet) or chips (high salt content). We encourage students to bring fresh fruit or vegetables for snacks. In addition, to celebrate a student's birthday with a cake please plan on using the afternoon break time to distribute. If you have a question please contact the homeroom teacher or front office for more information.
- **Student Insurance.** You will receive a receipt document for the student insurance. This fee is included in the school miscellaneous fee and this receipt is for your information. If you have any questions, please contact the office.
- ★ Traffic/Parking As a reminder when you are picking up the students at the end of the day please park to allow other vehicles to move through the parking area. Additional parking spaces in front of the academic building will be available this month.
 These spaces can only be used during after-school pick-up.



Long term parking - We are opening that grass space outside the auditorium for parking, especially those who will stay a long time, this is to accommodate as many cars as possible, especially during dismissal time. But it will not be in use during rainy days. If you come early or plan to stay please park next to the auditorium, we will mark off the area to assure that the traffic flow is maintained.



CURRICULUM



TOURCE STATE OF SET OF subject learning support for students came under review. After careful consideration and research, online access to more modern, interactive, student-centered resources programs was approved. We are very pleased to be able to provide access to these great learning resources for DISK students!



Middle School Study Skills: The new middle school study skills class has started off well. The goals of this course are to deal with a complex and changing course load in middle school which differs from elementary school. The organizational and planning skills which we will be covering over the course of the year will build a strong foundation for learning which will be used throughout their academic life into high school, university and beyond. Some of these skills will be organizational, team oriented, independent long term project management and personal responsibility. We plan to build on these useful skills throughout the following years.

This year teachers will participate in the improved design and planning of curriculum for Social Studies & History of study, Pre-K through grade 9 To be implemented in the school year 2021-2022. We are starting to plan on the school development into high school with next year starting a grade nine program. Through collaborative and practical approaches to curriculum writing review and activities through monthly in-school Professional Development sessions, it is anticipated that DISK's curriculum will be strengthened to more rigorously meet the assessment criteria outlined in the US Common Core State Standards.
