

General Announcements:

★ Invoice Receipt: For next year's tuition payment please ask the bank to put the student's name or ID number on the receipt. This will ensure that the student's files will be updated in a timely fashion. Please submit a copy of your receipt to the office.

Standardized Notebooks: Do not buy your notebooks from a stationary store. To help our students we will make DISK notebooks for each division. These notebooks will standardize the lines and size to help students prepare/organize their work, suited for teacher comment writing and parent note.

Complete School Uniform and proper footwear: We will be updating our uniform policy to include the new high school uniforms. Pre-K will continue to wear the DISK sport uniforms. K2 -Gr.5 students' uniforms will consist of white collared polo and shorts and jumpers or girls. *(continued)*



MS formal uniforms will be pants for boys, (no more shorts for formal uniforms. Black school shoes matching formal uniform and black rubber shoes ONLY for PE.

+ Academic Bldg classroom allocation:



All Specialty subjects and Homeroom classes from Pre-K to Gr. 5 will be using the Academic Bldg. The Middle School and HS Gr. 9 will temporarily be in the newly renovated Annex Bldg. 2nd Floor which was formerly the big space of

the School Chapel. This will be used until the new planned buildings of DISK are constructed. Details of this plan will be announced as soon as possible.

Drop-off and pick up scheme SY 2021-2022: All students from Pre-K to Gr. 5 directly go to the covered area and can go to their classroom at 7:45 am. after clocking in at the bottom of the stairs. The school nurse, Prefect of Discipline and a specialty teacher will be there to meet and greet the students. Every floor will also have a teacher to ensure students' safety and order.

Gr. 6 to Gr. 9 students will clock in at the front lobby's ID scanner then go directly to the Annex Bldg. 2nd floor where the Middle School and HS Gr.9 classrooms are temporarily located.


