### **\*** COVID-19 Restriction Update:

**Effective November 8** — We have received information from the CDC pertaining to school activities. Ms. Joanne Lee will confirm the status with Kaohsiung MOE.

Teachers (who have their vaccination shots and have passed the 14 day isolation period) do not need to wear masks while teaching. However, teachers should continue to maintain social distancing. Suggest that they still wear a mask while a student is closer than 1.5 meters.

Students should wear a mask while they are in the classroom.

Lunchroom protocol will remain the same (social distance and wearing masks).



A classroom should maintain cross ventilation in the classroom with or without AC.

Activities restrictions are lifted. Gathering for Thanksgiving and Christmas to be reviewed.

Parents are permitted on campus but should only be here to drop off or pick up students unless they have an appointment.


**DISK will go back to its regular dismissal schedule (3:30) starting November 8.** The safe zone DROP OFF/PICK UP NO PARKING AREA will remain a safe zone for students and parents.

We will keep you updated as we hear the latest. Thank you for your support and patience.

- **★ DISK Expanding:** With the addition of Grade 10 next school year, we will be starting the second phase of remodeling our annex area. The construction will take place during our holiday time (Christmas, Chinese New Year and summer break). We will be expanding the number of classrooms and developing a complete science lab for experiments for Biology and Chemistry. We will also be adding restrooms for the use of MS/HS.
- \*After-School Pick-up Procedure: We received a concern from our neighbors about the LONG LINE of PARENTS WAITING on the road. Car smoke enters their home.
- ★ Friday Pick-up Time: Recently some students have been given permission from their parents to go home with other students, or to walk out of the school grounds on their own. School policy dictates that parents submit a written notice to the school so that we can better provide for their safety. Please send written notice to the school administration if you plan for your child to leave school under any special circumstances.
- ★ Dress Code: As colder weather is coming, please be advised that we have Jacket requirements.

- ★ House Point Winners: The 'STARS' SLOs House points system is geared to help in spreading the positive tone of DISK students' educational growth. - **School Hours:** School hours are **8:00 am to 3:30 pm** unless adjusted by the Administration for special events. Students are to be **in** their classroom by **8:00 am**. Late pick-up should be arranged through the office as each situation occurs. Students must wait in the lobby until they are released to go home. The office closes at 4:30 students waiting for later pick up will be sent to the gate house. When students are not picked up on time many students become agitated and worrisome.
- **Student Leaving Campus:** From our student Parent handbook:

Parents/guardians must pick up their children in person or give written permission to a designated family member to collect children from school. If it is not written (email) then the student can not leave. Verbal transmission on the day of request is not accepted. Parents can send an email (not Line). The school may call to confirm when we receive it.

**ID cards and checking in:** We have been monitoring the Tardies and Absences based on the record of students checking in with their ID cards. Please remind the students of the importance of checking in and being at school on time. Excess tardies or forgetting their ID cards resulting in an absent recording will affect the student's opportunity for honors.
